

Biesse: results for Q4 2002 approved

In Q4 2002:

- § Turnover increased 28.5% to €130.5 million
- § Profitability increased significantly (EBITDA +97.2%, EBIT +144.5%)
- § Net financial position improved, reaching €85.8 million

Pesaro, 14 February 2003 – Today, the Board of Directors of Biesse S.p.A. has approved the quarterly report for the period ended 31 December 2002. Biesse is an Italian company with headquarters in Pesaro. It is quoted on the Star segment of the Italian stock exchange, and is one of the world's leading operators on the market of machines and systems for the processing of wood, glass and marble.

In Q4 2002, consolidated turnover amounted to $\notin 130.5$ million, up 28.5% compared to the same period in 2001. EBITDA also registered a significant increase and amounted to $\notin 12.4$ million (9.5% of turnover), up 97.2% compared to the same period of the previous year, when it was $\notin 6.3$ million (6.2% of turnover). Operating profit increased by 144.5% reaching the amount of $\notin 7.8$ million (5.9% of turnover) with respect to $\notin 3.2$ in Q4 2001 (3.1% of turnover).

In Q4 the net financial position, which was €-85.8% million, improved and equaled the levels posted for December 2001.

As regards progressive data referring to the period 1 January - 31 December 2002, consolidated turnover amounted to \in 371 million, up 4.8% compared to \in 353.8 million in 2001. EBITDA was \in 22.1 million (6% of turnover) compared to \in 25.4 million in 2001 (7.2% of turnover). Operating profit was \in 8 million (2.2% of turnover) compared to \in 13.9 million in 2001 (3.9% of turnover).

"We are satisfied with the results for Q4", highlighted Claudio Granuzzo, General Manager of Biesse, "even though the positive trend registered in the second half of the year did not make it possible to offset the negative trend for the first six months". Corporate process changes have led to encouraging results in terms of efficiency. These actions will be carried forward in 2003 as well, in order to further recover Group profitability".

Moreover, the Board of Directors has acknowledged the resignation of Director Werner Deuring, who maintains his 4.8% stake in Biesse. The Board of Directors of Biesse thanked him for his unfailing commitment and professionalism.
