Biesse approves the third-quarter results for 2001
Biesse, one of the world's leading players in the market of machinery and systems for working wood, glass and marble, closed the third quarter with a value of production of L 537.8 billion\*

Pesaro, 14 November 2001 – The Board of Directors of Biesse, the Pesaro company that has been listed for trading in the Star segment of the Italian stock exchange since last 22 June, approved the financial statements for the first nine months of 2001.

In the nine-month period, the value of production reached L 537.8 billion\* with a gross operating profit of L 37 billion\*, for 6.9% of the value of production\*.

Operating profit reached L 20.7 billion, equal to 3.9% of the value of production\*, while net indebtedness amounted to L 126.9 billion.

"In the first nine months of 2001, when the declining growth prospects in North America led to a slowdown in the world economy, Biesse recorded a positive trend in orders from the mediterranean area – in particular from the domestic market and the markets of Eastern Europe and the Far East," stated Piero Valentini, CEO of Biesse SpA.

Valentini went on to add that "the renewed confidence in the international economy will enable the reference sector, and Biesse in particular, to continue its historic growth trend, especially in the field of high-tech machinery – in which Biesse is a market leader and that represents the driving force for the entire industry".
